Ever since its establishment, iThemba has served as a pivotal platform for both the Entity and the iLembe family of municipalities. This platform has been instrumental in showcasing an array of projects, programs, and initiatives, all directed towards the realization of the overarching vision: the transformation of the iLembe District into a sustainable, people-centric economic nucleus. With a strategic focus on positioning iLembe as a centre of growth and development, the synergy between all stakeholders is consistently fortified.

Tourism is known to be a major contributor to the iLembe District economy and we are pleased that this sector is starting to show recovery. Prior to the COVID-19 global pandemic, total visitor expenditure GDP contributions in 2019 amounted to an estimated R2.2 billion. The following year in 2020 total visitor expenditure contribution to GDP decreased by 26%. The decline was primarily due to restrictions to travel and strict lockdown regulations. In 2021, efforts to ensure economic recovery in the tourism sector resulted in R2.6 billion in total GDP contributions. The impact of the July 2021 riots and April 2022 floods in the KZN Province resulted in an estimated decline of about 5% in GDP contributions for January to June 2022. The notable contribution of R3.4 billion in 2023 underscores the resilience and recovery exhibited by the iLembe District's tourism sector, signifying growth in a post-pandemic landscape. Highlights of the tourism industry report can be found on page 6 of this publication.

In line with the mandate of positioning and marketing the region as a premier tourism destination, the Entity participated in key trade, business and consumer tourism exhibitions which included Meetings Africa, World Travel Market (WTM) Africa and the Africa Travel Indaba.

Whilst the general rise in cost of living remains a major concern and affects most people across the country, the Entity as an implementing agent of various projects /support programmes remains at the forefront of driving economic development and continues to partner with communities, sector departments, local municipalities, and the private sector to ensure that projects are successfully implemented.

Message from the CEO

These projects include the establishment of the Invest SA One-Stop-Shop, the Maxwell Hadebe Digital Centre in Ndwedwe, the KwaShuShu Hotsprings & Ntunjambili Project in Maphumulo as well as several agricultural projects across the district. The iLembe Business Incubator continues to provide invaluable support to SMMEs in the form of workspace, training, and access to markets and capital.

The launch of the iLembe Business Directory is another highlight, the directory is aimed to supporting local businesses with a free 'live' platform to showcase products and services. If you have not yet registered, you are encouraged to not miss this opportunity.

Of concern is the negative business sentiment which resulted in the 2023 Mid-Year Business Confidence Index being recorded at 48.3 index points which is a decline of .7 index points when compared to the 2nd half of 2022, and a 1.8 index point decline year on year. This sentiment was mainly shaped by several macro and local factors - with more Gigawatt hours being load shed in the first 5 months of 2023 than in the whole of 2022, damaged electronic equipment, reduced production capacity and increased operational costs as businesses invest in load shedding mitigation measures. The cost-of-living crisis manifested itself in fuel, fertiliser, and stubbornly high food prices, setting the trend for headline inflation. Locally, delays in repairing road infrastructure following the KZN floods of 2022, the beach closures in the neighbouring eThekwini Metro, and business rescue interventions at Tongaat Hulett and Gledhow Sugar, formed the background to a challenging 1st half of 2023 (iLembe iBCl, August 2023).

Notwithstanding the negative business sentiment, the economic activity index in the District remained positive, which represents a fifth successive period of positive economic activity. The status of the District as an attractive investment destination was further reinforced by several large scale private investments that are at various stages of development. Notable investments such as the ALPLA recycling plant and Club Med resort are scheduled to commence construction in the second half of 2023 and early 2024 respectively.

During the preceding six months, we welcomed Ms Hlengiwe Hakata (Chief Finance Officer), and Ms Nobuhle Ngcobo (Marketing and Communications Officer) to the Enterprise iLembe family. We wish them a successful and fulfilling tenure.



Tourism a Major Economic Driver

Tourism continues to play a major role in driving the economy of the iLembe District. The recent tourism industry research shows that tourism numbers to the region has been increasing as tourists continue to choose the destination for leisure holidays. Some of the highlights of the survey for the period January – June 2023 shows that;

- The direct jobs created by the visitor spend from January to June 2023, potentially supported an estimated 1 973 jobs over a year.
- 2023 has shown remarkable growth in GDP contribution surpassing that of 2019, indicating that the tourism sector in iLembe has started to recover and is showing actual growth post-pandemic.
- The estimated total contribution to the GDP was R3.4 billion from January to June 2023. This means that over R2.3 billion in indirect and induced GDP impacts was added to the economy as a result of the direct expenditure of visitors.
- The estimated tourist expenditure was calculated by multiplying the average spend per visitor by the number of visitors. The total visitor expenditure amounted was calculated at R2.2 billion, which was 37% more than what was generated in 2022 (R1.6 billion) from January to June.

KZN CONVENTION BUREAU STAKEHOLDERS' BREAKFAST ENGAGEMENT

Enterprise iLembe attended the KZN Convention Bureau Stakeholders' Breakfast Engagement that was held on the 25 April 2023 at the Maharani Hotel Sky Venue. The breakfast engagement aimed to discuss Business Events opportunities and the role of the KZN Convention Bureau in hosting of such events in the province. FOOD AND BEVERAGE MANUFACTURING SETA SKILLS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME INDUCTION

Enterprise iLembe in partnership with the FoodBev Seta hosted an induction session on Friday 17 March 2023 at the iLembe Auditorium in KwaDukuza, to congratulate and stimulate the 100 learners who have been selected to participate in the Food and Beverage Manufacturing Seta Skills Development Programme.

The programme will run for a duration of twelve 12 months, which will be theoretical training for 3 months and workplace learning for 9 months. The theoretical training commenced on the 06th of February 2023 across all Local Municipalities within the iLembe District, where learners are being trained on NQF Level 1: NC: Food and Beverage Handling Processes, NQF Level 1: NC: Business Practices and NQF Level 3: NC: Food and Beverage Generic Management.

The programme seeks to address economic growth, drive transformation and innovation, encourage employment creation, enable social development, and address the national government imperatives. With hospitality and tourism sector being one of the key economic drivers for the region it is important that opportunities are created for youth to enter and excel in this sector. This skills development programme will serve as an enabler in addressing the gaps that exist in local skills within the hospitality industry.

ENTERPRISE ILEMBE SMME BUSINESS SUPPORT (HANDOVER)

As part of Enterprise iLembe's mandate to support micro, small, and medium enterprises, Enterprise iLembe utilized the Let's Talk Youth Entrepreneurship event platform to distribute business support grants to small, medium, and micro enterprises (SMMEs) from the iLembe Business Incubator. The grants will provide crucial support and resources to empower the growth and success of these local businesses.





KZN EDTEA OPERATION VULA FUND

An Operation Vula funding workshop was held on the 14 of June at Business incubator. Operation Vula Fund is a programme that enables cooperative and SMMEs owned by women, youth, and people with disabilities to access funding for the establishment and expansion of business. The programme operates under the auspice of KZNEDTEA and Enterprise iLembe as a local development agency was involved in the process of fund application by assisting

farmers with business plans and ensuring that farmers have and meet all funding requirements. The fund has three categories, tier one with funds ranging from R0 to R50 000, tier two with funds ranging from R50 000 to R300 000 and tier three with funds ranging from R300 000 to R2 000 000. The below mentioned project were assisted with funding applications.



LET'S TALK ENTREPRENEURSHIP

LUNGINHLANHLA PROJECT

Business overview and background

Lunginhlahla Projects trading as Qandalami is an agribusiness that specializes in the production and selling of eggs. The company is a 100% B-BBEE female owned company established in 2020.

It started as a small home-based broiler business breeding up to 100 birds at a time and has a record of farming sugarcane as well. Lunginhlahla Projects operates on a fully paid privately owned sugarcane farm located in Mangethe on a long-term lease which is renewable every 10 years. A total of 6 hectares of the non-cane land has been leased and ample to accommodate future expansion plans of the poultry business. The business was fully grant funded by the Agribusiness Development Agency and is currently producing eggs on a 10 000-layer unit and plan to expand to a 30 000-layer unit in the next in 5 years (2028).

Business location and facilities

A business location refers to that place or structure occupied by a company to run its operations. This includes any structure or establishment that is used in conducting business. The farm location is in Mangethe area, in ward 3 of Mandeni local Municipality under iLembe District Municipality. The company leased the land from Izimpande Farming Cooperative with a lease term of 10 years. The area of the farm is 6 hectares.

Products/Services

Egg production – the plan is to initially produce eggs from a 10 000 layers system and supply to a direct market and expand the business in increments of 5 000 layers per year when market conditions improve.

KWA-ZULU NATAL COGTA LEGISLATURE SERVICE DELIVERY IN NDWEDWE

The aim of the meeting was to share ideas with different stakeholders on fast tracking service delivery but mainly in addressing the economic growth of Ndwedwe communities especially through agricultural interventions.



PROVINCIAL AGRICULTURAL INDABA

KwaZulu-Natal Premier Ms Nomusa Dube-Ncube with MEC for Agriculture and Rural Development Mr. S Zuma launched the Provincial Agricultural Indaba at Msunduze Sport Field in Mandeni Local Municipality on the 04 March 2023. The aim was to engage on obstacles that the province face on a day-to-day basis, such as livestock theft, load shedding and food insecurity in KwaZulu-Natal. During the launch of the Agricultural Indaba, the Premier unveiled a fleet of Yellow Plant equipment such as trucks, tractors, TLBs and Excavators. The equipment will assist farmers with construction of agricultural infrastructure and infield roads which will improve access to the market thus enabling farmers to transport produce.

Minister of Agriculture, Land Reform and Rural Development Ms.Thokozile Didiza and MEC for Agriculture and Rural Development, Mr. S Zuma handed over Agricultural inputs at Nced'omhlophe Sports Ground in Mandeni Local Municipality on the 3rd of April 2023. The aim was to engage on obstacles that the farmers face on a day-to-day basis, high cost of agricultural, market opportunities and handing over of agricultural inputs to households.



LUNGINHLANHLA EGG PRODUCTION LAUNCH

KwaZulu Natal Honorable MEC for Agriculture and Rural Development, Mr. S Zuma together with Agricultural Development Agency (ADA), Launched and handed over Egg Layer project to Lunginhlanhla co-operative in Mandeni Local Municipality, Ward 9 on the 23rd of June 2023.The project was funded by ADA. Lunginhlanhla was funded with an installation and equipment of automotive 10 000-unit layer structure. The aim of the launch was to encourage youth to participate in agricultural projects to create job opportunities.



CHURCH OF JESUS CHRIST OF THE LATTER-DAY SAINTS

Enterprise iLembe and the Church of Jesus Christ of The Latter-day Saints visited three projects that were assisted with infrastructural development. The aim of the visit was for the church's communication department to meet with beneficiaries and to measure sustainability of the project. The church's delegation was led by Mr Sandile Makasi who is an Executive director of Communications. Projects visited were KwaSkhonyane Co-operative (Mandeni), Groutville Farming Co-operative (KwaDukuza) and Siyathuthuka Nofuhla Co-operative (Maphumulo). These are some of the efforts to strengthen the relationship between the LDS Charities and Enterprise iLembe for the benefit of local farmers.



ZIMBABWE ORGANIC FARMING MISSION

ILembe District has been identified by Provincial Government to lead the introduction of organic farming practices, particularly targeting emerging farmers. Organic farming has potentially positive outputs for small-scale farmers, especially with growing consumer interest in healthy foods such as fresh fruits and vegetables. The pharmaceuticals industry is also a large market for various organic medicinal herbs. A visit to the LaRochelle organics in Zimbabwe was conducted by Enterprise iLembe and the District Mayor in June 2023. The visit mainly targeted community agri-projects that currently export organic produce to the EuropeanUnion, particularly Germany. Enterprise iLembe will be rolling out the organic farming project in the district focusing primarily on rural communities.





Enterprise iLembe Welcomes New Chief Financial Officer

Enterprise iLembe welcomed its new Chief Financial Officer, Mrs Hlengiwe Hakata on the 1st February 2023. Ms Hakata started her professional career at the Auditor General of South Africa (AGSA) in 2009 and qualified as a Chartered Accountant in 2014. At the commemoration, the KwaZulu-Natal Provincial Government also awarded cheques worth over R600 000 businesses-owned by young people and cooperatives in and around llembe District municipal area.
